BEACH PATROL

The purpose of the beach patrol is to have one person on the beach with the authority to maintain order and safety, to enforce the posted rules, to prevent outsiders and non-guests from using the beach facilities, and to prevent parking on the grass. The person serving as patrol will wear a helmet and carry a whistle. Both helmet and whistle will be in front of the home of Mrs. J. Montgomery, in a box, directly across from the beach. The guard on early shift will procure this equipment from Montgomery's and the last shift guard will be responsible for returning same. The two shifts shall be divided as follows:

12:00-2:30 and 2:30-5:00 daily, except on Tuesday and Thursday during the weeks of swimming lessons.

You have been assigned days on which to patrol. If you are unable to fulfill your assignment, it is your responsibility to find a substitute or exchange time with someone else.

WE ARE ASKING EACH PERSON BEFORE GOING ON PATROL DUTY TO CALL THE NEXT PERSON AND REMIND THEM.

Duties of Beach Patrol:

1. Check for unfamiliar people. They must have a metal tag or permission note from property owner for specific day.
2. No eating, bottles or cans of beverages are allowed.
3. NO DOGS, PLEASE.
4. No rowdiness allowed on the pier, raft or beach.
5. See that children put bikes in racks provided to keep the lawn area clear.
6. If you have any trouble when you ask strangers for identification or they will not leave when asked to, or any other serious problem, please call the Lake County Sheriff's office, MA 3-1855. We are under their jurisdiction.
